News from Portugal




Thanks to donations we have been able to hold summer camps for children. We made the best of our situation and supported Adonía's program for the summer and it turned into a really worthwhile camp. The children's relatives in particular have thanked us and were so grateful for this camp.



Another summer program for children, was held in conjunction with two artists who also are teachers. They go out to the poorer areas, outside the capital, and as they arrive, the children come running. Penka teaches them to paint and tells them stories from the Bible, while Hari Atanasov speaks to the adults, answering their questions about why they do so much for the kids and help them.



At the Foundation, when someone calls at the door or on the phone, we never know who and what they are coming for. A Swedish lady who moved here, for example, had to leave her rented house for a flat and there was furniture and heating system and other things left over. It came as a blessing for us. And an airline company changed their uniforms and gave us lots of new jackets, trousers and shirts. Although. before we could give them away, all the gold and silver braiding had to be taken off.







Other people empty their cupboards and come with everything from clothing to shoes and even ornaments.
