



Every day we hear about fires. In January, a major tragedy occurred when eight died and 46 were injured, 13 of which very seriously, in Tondela, the village where everyone knows everyone. Many on the ground floor were watching a football match and upstairs were all their friends. Suddenly fire started on the roof upstairs and someone who saw it opened a window and then, when oxygen came in, there was a terrible explosion. Two hundred firefighters arrived, but too late. Everything was already over. And in the areas where we have sent several major shipments are children whose parents have gone. Thousands of hectares of forest went up in smoke throughout the country, etc.



An immigrant volunteer sends his message; "I have learned that in life there is nothing that you can be sure of owning the next day. . So, it's best to be grateful for what you have, even if you've not that much. And to thank God for food for the day and the roof over your head. I see that those who the Foundation help, who have very little, put great value on whatever they receive, such as a warm sweater. "
